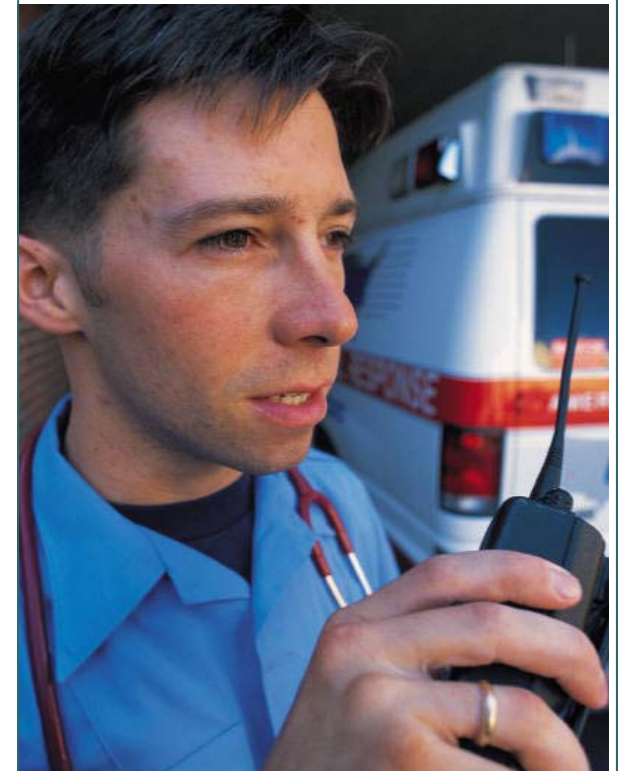

About the Presenter

Don Kamin, PhD

Dr. Kamin is a clinical psychologist who has been employed in a variety of clinical and administrative positions in outpatient mental health centers, inpatient psychiatric units, forensic services, emergency mental health, and county government. He received an undergraduate degree from Vassar College and completed predoctoral training at Case Western Reserve University School of Medicine/University Hospitals of Cleveland prior to receiving his doctorate in clinical psychology from Ohio University. Dr. Kamin completed postdoctoral training in forensic psychology at the University of Rochester Medical Center/Strong Hospital.

Dr. Kamin was previously the Director of Community Services / Mental Health Director for Wyoming County. He is currently the Director of Adult Service Quality and System Development at Coordinated Care Services, Inc. in Rochester where he works with mental health providers to assess and improve outcomes. Dr. Kamin also serves as the Supervising Clinical Consultant / Forensic Liaison for the Monroe County Office of Mental Health working closely with law enforcement and others in the criminal justice system to address the needs of individuals with mental illness through system reform and training initiatives. He is currently a consultant to the NYS Division of Criminal Justice Services helping develop and deliver training to law enforcement personnel across New York State.

Dr. Kamin is a frequently requested presenter for "first responder" audiences – most of whom have had minimal formal training in mental health. His engaging and interactive presentation style has been rated highly by EMS providers who have commented that he provides useful strategies for dealing with individuals exhibiting signs of emotional disturbance.
